

Celebrating Achievement in Exploration - Nomination Form

The Explorers Club Canadian Chapter Awards and Honours Committee encourages members to nominate worthy individuals who are Associates, Members, or Fellows in good standing with the club. There are two possible award categories.

1. **Stefansson** -The Stefansson Medal honours *outstanding contributions to the cause of exploration and/or field sciences in Canada or internationally by exceptionally meritorious members of the Canadian chapter* of the Explorers Club. This award is somewhat analogous to ***a lifetime achievement award*** for members who have been long-time affiliates of the club (although consideration is certainly given to exceptional feats of exploration, field science, or related, regardless of length of membership), and have met the criteria listed below. One medal will be awarded annually to provide an opportunity for the Canadian Chapter of The Explorers Club to recognize:
 - a. Members who have distinguished themselves by feats of exploration and/or field sciences of national or international significance, through either a singular event of great significance (i.e. Moon landing), or during their career as an explorer or researcher, and/or
 - b. Members who have given *outstanding service to the Canadian Chapter* of The Explorers Club in terms of raising the profile, and visibility of the club within Canada (and Internationally) through their involvement on the organizational or leadership front.

2. **Citation of Merit** - The Citation of Merit is awarded annually to recognize a ***commendable feat of exploration or services to the Canadian Chapter*** of The Explorers Club. Multiple recipients can receive this award annually, and it is open to Fellows, Members, and Student Members of The Explorers Club. Examples worthy of nomination include: recognizing directors/ volunteers who have made significant contributions to the club during the award period; Canadian chapter members who have led or participated in significant expeditions (flag or otherwise, and based on findings); have produced significant research; received accolades for their exploration
